POLICY TITLE <u>GUIDING PRINCIPLES AND OBJECTIVES FOR BUILDINGS AND</u> <u>SITES No. 800</u>

This series of the board policy manual sets forth the board objectives and goals for the school district's buildings and sites. It is the goal of the board to provide sufficient school district buildings and sites for the education program. The board will strive to provide an environment which will encourage and support learning and the overall objectives of the school district.

In providing this environment the school district buildings and sites will accommodate the organizational and instructional patterns that support the education program. The board has final authority to determine what is necessary to meet the needs of the education program.

The board has full and final responsibility for the selection of sites, employment of personnel, contracting for services, approval of plans, authorization and acceptance of bids, and payment for work performed on contractual agreements; the board also has the responsibility for final acceptance or rejection of work done.

It is the responsibility of the superintendent to oversee the day-to-day operations of the school buildings and sites and to notify the board of areas in need of improvement.

The superintendent shall be responsible for organizing and coordinating the efforts of the various individuals and groups to best achieve the established educational objectives of the building program, and for making recommendations to the board.
