



Guidance Elementary

1.0 Students will acquire the attitudes, knowledge and skills that contribute to lifelong learning.

- 1.1 Display a positive interest in learning.

7.0 Students will develop the attitudes, knowledge, and interpersonal skills to help them understand and respect self and others.

- 7.1 Distinguish between appropriate and inappropriate behaviors.

7.3 Recognize, accept, and appreciate ethnic and cultural diversity.

7.4 Demonstrate cooperative behavior in groups.

7.5 Recognize that everyone has rights and responsibilities.

8.0 Students will make decisions, set goals and take necessary actions to achieve goals.
