1.0 Students will acquire the attitudes, knowledge and skills that contribute to lifelong learning.

6.0 Students will understand the relationship between personal qualities, education and the world of work.

6.2 Identify personal preferences and interests, which influence career choices and success.

7.0 Students will develop the attitudes, knowledge, and interpersonal skills to help them understand and respect self and others.

7.3 Recognize, accept, and appreciate ethnic and cultural diversity.
