**1.0 Use the target language to engage in conversation in which they will express feelings and emotions and exchange opinions and information.**

- 1.1 The students will be able to persuade, advise and suggest.
- 1.2 The students will be able to narrate past events.

**2.0 Understand and interpret the written and spoken target language on a variety of topics from diverse media.**

- 2.1 The students will read and present news in the target language.
- 2.2 The students will be able to interpret material from various sources in the target language.

**3.0 Present in the target language information, concepts, and ideas to an audience of listeners or readers on a variety of topics.**

- 3.1 The students will be able to express agreement and disagreement.
- 3.2 The students will be able to write essays and present skits on a variety of topics.

**4.0 Demonstrate knowledge and understanding of traditional ideas and perspectives, institutions, the arts, and other components of the target culture.**

- 4.1 The students will identify typical sports in target language countries.
- 4.2 The students will be able to read recipes and make traditional foods.
- 4.3 The students will recognize major cultural influences.

**5.0 Demonstrate an understanding of the nature of language through comparisons of the target language and their own.**

- 5.1 The students will learn and be able to present perfect tense and the present subjunctive.
