Identification for Extended Learning Program

Staff are beginning the review process for ELP identification for the 2023-2024 school year. Data on students is reviewed using multiple types of criteria including standardized tests and student work samples, as well as teacher and parent ratings. In late May, letters are sent to those that data shows have a need for support for academic challenge. The letter will explain options for your child, including programming available such as extensions in the classroom and services in the areas of Humanities and/or STEM. These options depend upon the level of service identified as a need, so the letters are specific for each child. While classroom teachers work to differentiate for many children, ELP staff provides direct service to a smaller population.
