<u>May 2024</u>

Students had the opportunity to practice the ABCD (Analyze, Brainstorm, Consequences, Demonstrate) problem solving strategy with their Dragon Time with a school wide challenge. Over the past several weeks, each Dragon Time has created a short video highlighting a conflict and how to resolve it. NEW PICK-UP AND DROP-OFF GUIDELINES



We have updated our pick-up/drop-off guidelines to ensure everyone stays

<u>safe:</u>

- 1. OUR PARKING LOT WILL BE CLOSED DURING DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP. PLEASE USE THE CARPOOL LANE DURING THESE TIMES.
- 2. When in the carpool lane for pick-up & drop-off please pull your vehicle all the way up behind the car in front of you. If you are first in line, please drive past the entrance and stop at the second light pole.
- 3. Staff will be on duty at the front of the building from 7:25 AM 7:40 AM for arrivals.
- 4. Staff will also be on duty from 2:50 PM- 3:00 PM for dismissal.

IMPORTANT REMINDER:

A Johnston city ordinance states that drivers are not allowed to block a crosswalk under any circumstances. When a crosswalk is blocked, Crossing Guards are not allowed to assist students across the street until the crosswalk is clear. It also creates issues for neighborhood walkers, joggers and cyclists.
