

PICK-UP & DROP-OFF GUIDELINES



Here is some guidance on how to help make pick-up and drop-off traffic flow smoothly:

- 1. Staff will be on duty at the front of the building from 7:25 AM 7:45 AM for arrivals.
- 2. Staff will also be on duty from 2:50 PM- 3:00 PM for dismissal.

- 3. When in the carpool lane for pick-up & drop-off please pull your vehicle all the way up behind the car in front of you. If you are first in line, please drive past the entrance and stop at the second light pole.
- 4. Parking lot drop-offs are not permitted for safety reasons. Please be sure to have an adult escort students to the front door if you prefer to use the parking lot.

IMPORTANT REMINDER:

A Johnston city ordinance states that drivers are not allowed to block a crosswalk under any circumstances. When a crosswalk is blocked, Crossing Guards are not allowed to assist students across the street until the crosswalk is clear. It also creates issues for neighborhood walkers, joggers and cyclists.

Thank you for your cooperation and support as we continue to work together to keep our students safe.


