POLICY TITLE SUMMER LEARNING PROGRAMS

No. 603.2

The district recognizes the importance of ongoing learning opportunities for students. As such, the district shall offer summer school instruction in accordance with the following:

- The district may offer to enrich and extend the educational program provided during the regular academic year. Enrichment programs may or may not relate specifically to district curriculum but offer meaningful growth experiences to students. The district will weigh the benefit to the students and the school district as well as the school district's budget and availability of licensed employees to conduct summer school.
- If a child who is eligible for special education has data indicating a need for extended school year services as necessary to receive a free appropriate public education, as determined according to state and federal law, such services shall be provided as described in the child's individualized education program.
- In additional instances as provided by law.

These programs may be funded by fees charged to participants.

The Executive Director of Teaching and Learning may develop administrative regulations regarding this policy.
