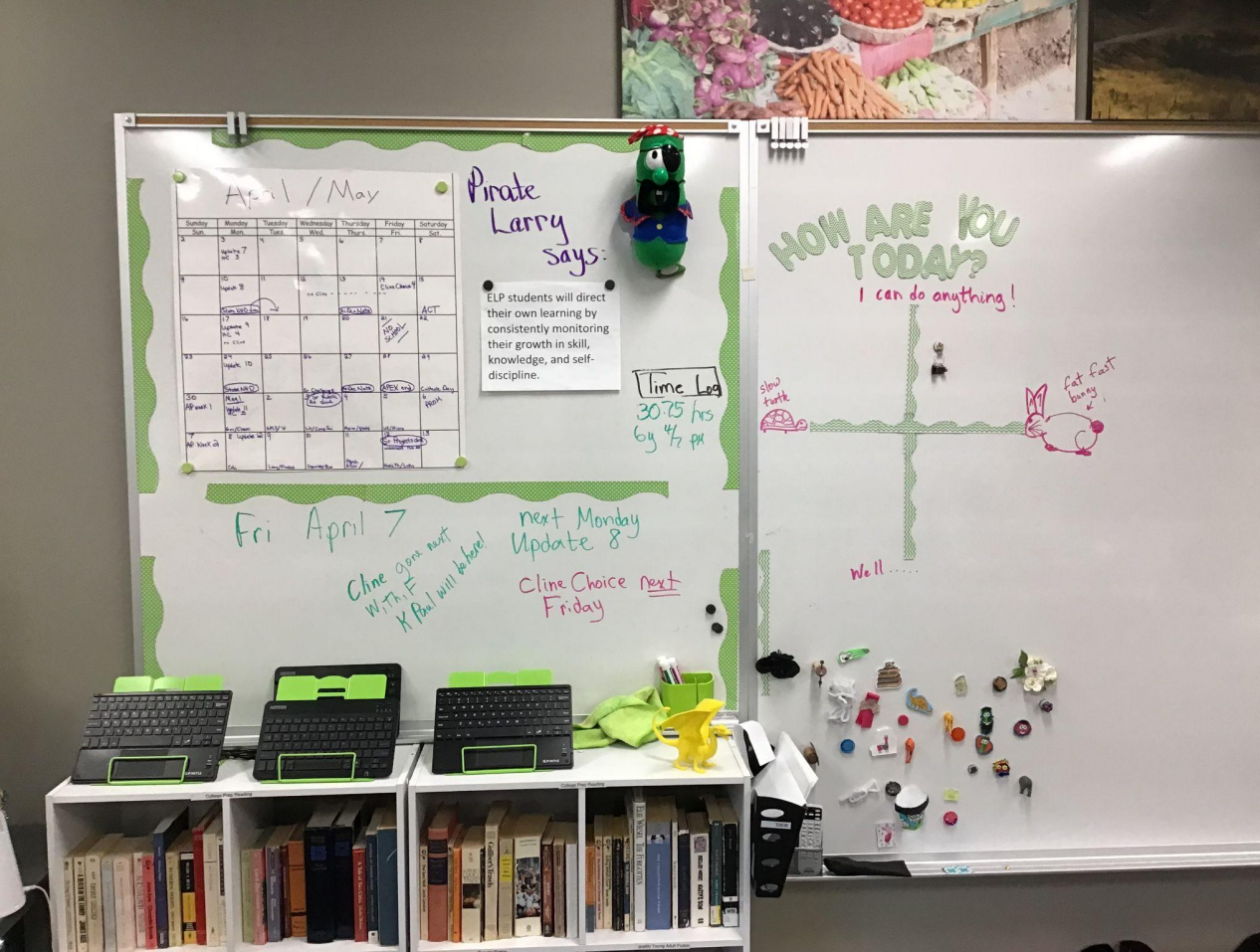
What happens in room 426?

Students may need to check the calendar.

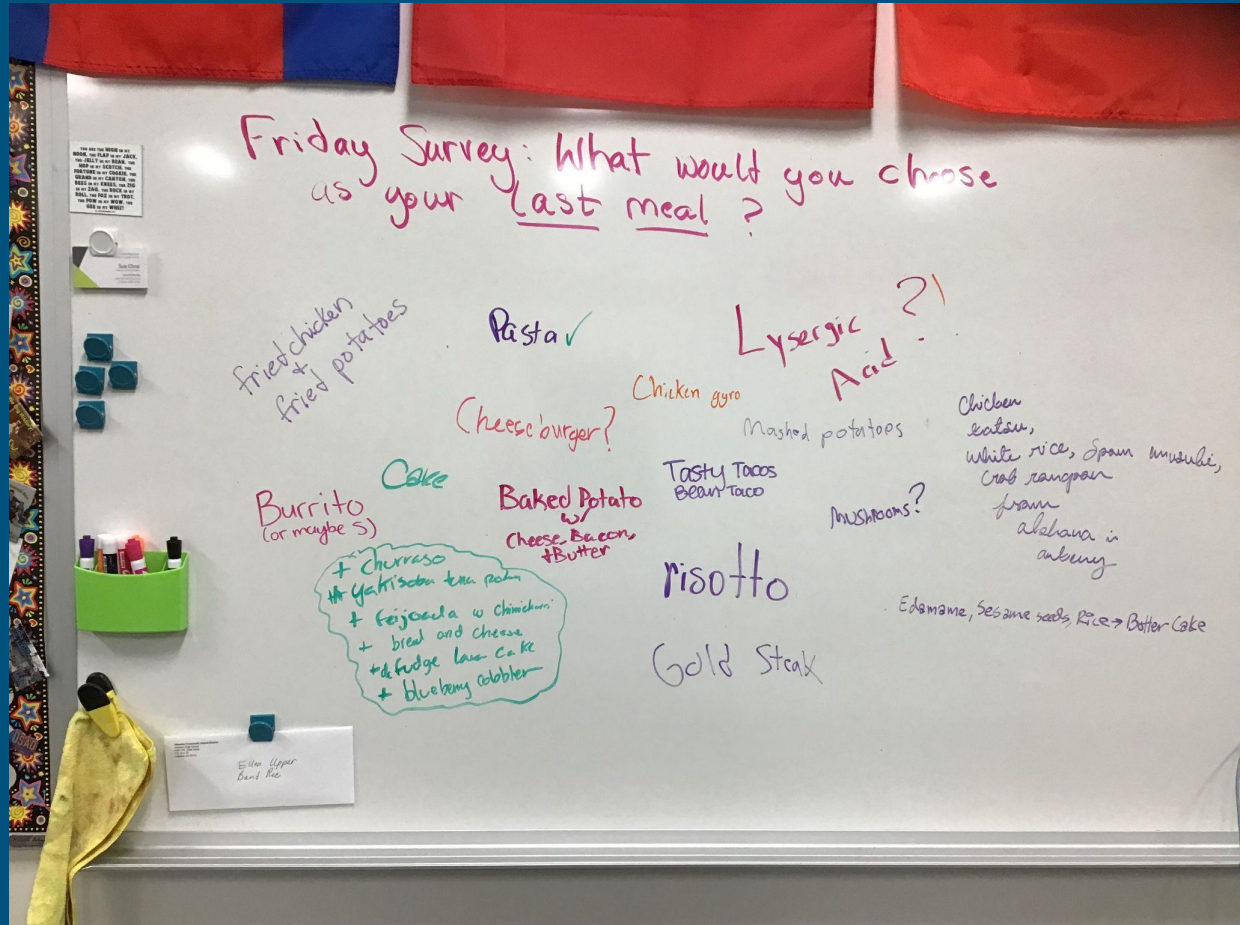
All kinds of people come in to do a mental health check.

We have pillows and blankets to make you more comfortable if you like to work on the floor.

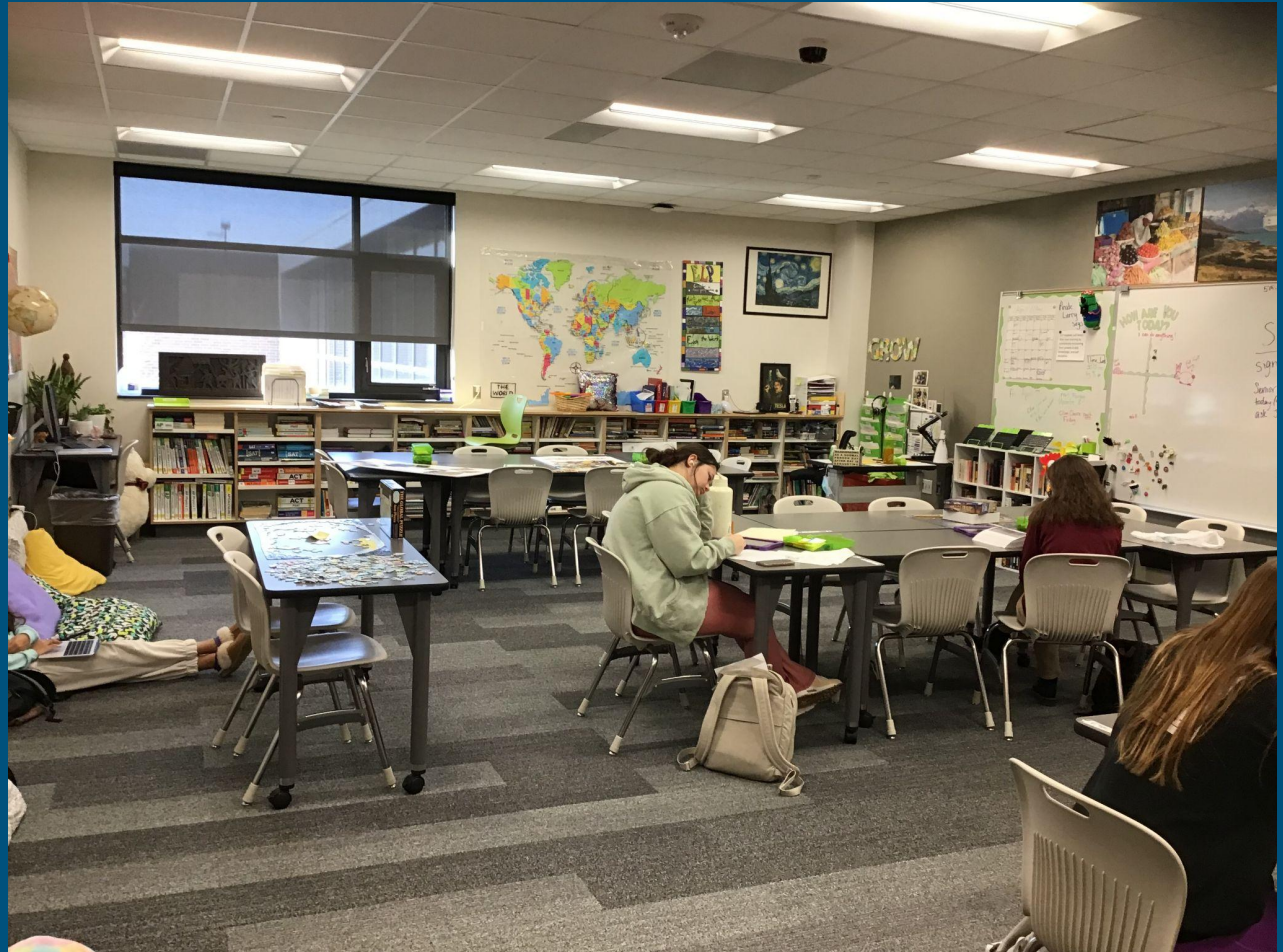
There's a large
