

Why Logic is Important

- <u>Exercise for the brain:</u> Learning to apply logical reasoning through games & puzzles helps stimulate the brain while developing skills such as patience, memory, and concentration.
- <u>Develop critical thinking skills:</u> When children grow up and face real-world problems, they will be better equipped to solve them if they have strong logical thinking skills. They will be ready to think outside the box, independently.
- <u>Helps with academic skills:</u> Logical thinking helps students learn to solve problems and come up with more/different solutions, which can help them in other areas like math and reading.




