The fall 2022 semester brought so much fun and excitement for our district. We welcomed a new mascot, JD, who spent time at all five of the elementary schools during homecoming

week. Then, Johnston captured the state championship in men's golf and our varsity football team made it to the UNI Dome for the first time in history. Our swim and dive team won the regional championship and also broke several records at state. The varsity marching band claimed two 1st place wins. Nineteen students made All-State Choir, while six made All-State Band. And Beaver Creek Elementary celebrated its 25th birthday.

New and exciting things continue to happen. We have 19 paraeducators and seven students participating in a state apprenticeship program that offers a pathway to becoming educators. The program provides paid on-the-job training while gaining licensure or a bachelor's degree.

Thirteen students are taking a new EMT (emergency medical technician) course that's allowing them to learn about a health care profession in high demand. They're getting paid while gaining hands-on experience including time in an ambulance and emergency room. And almost 100 JHS students are taking online courses through DMACC and earning college credit. We continue to work toward improving student achievement as identified in the district's mission, vision and strategic plan. The Iowa School Performance Profile shows that overall, Johnston's test scores are higher than the state average. You can view more detailed information by school building at <u>iaschoolperformance.gov</u>. In addition, we recently learned that five JHS students are semifinalists in the 68th annual National Merit Scholarship Program.

The district has taken several steps to make safety and well-being a priority this year. We provided safety training for about 1,000 staff members before the start of the fall semester. New SEBMH (Social-Emotional, Behavior, Mental Health) Interventionists are working directly with students in schools. A new assessment called SAEBRS is helping identify students who may benefit from additional support. In addition, some JHS students played a leadership role in a national conference on student wellness.

2-Year-Old Preschool

2-Year-Old Preschool is a fun and lively time to help kids develop skills and abilities through age-appropriate learning with activities, stories, songs, snack and center choice exploratory time. Each class has a max of 12 students and two teachers. **Child must be 2 by September 15, 2023 to enroll.**

3-Year-Old Preschool

3-Year-Old Preschool follows the "Creative Curriculum for Preschool" to teach early literacy concepts, Zaner Bloser writing, and Everyday Math. 2023-2024 Registration

Classes are first come, first serve. **If your desired course is full, add your child to the waitlist.** If there are cancellations that create openings, we will contact those on the waitlist first.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

2) Pay the \$65 one-time, non-refundable program fee. *A scholarship may be available. This scholarship provides financial assistance for families who qualify to help cover the expense of 2 or 3-Year-Old Preschool tuition. Applications are at johnstoncsd.org/school/johnston-ela.*

3) Enter your information, and you will receive an email with next steps in the registration process. **Note, registration is not final until all steps have been completed.**

4) Turn in a hard copy of your child's physical and immunization records to the JELA office (6207 NW 62nd Ave).

4-Year-Old Preschool

4-Year-Old Preschool uses the "Creative Curriculum for Preschool" to prepare kids for kindergarten. Kids are challenged to grow socially, physically, emotionally and cognitively. There is a focus on adapting to future school environments and routines. Each class has a maximum of 20 students and two teachers. JELA receives funding from the Iowa Statewide Voluntary Preschool Program to provide an opportunity for all 4-year-old children in the state of Iowa to enter school ready to learn by expanding access to quality preschool curricula. **Child must be 4 by September 15, 2023 to enroll.**




