POLICY TITLE DISTRIBUTION OF MATERIALS

No. 903.5

The board recognizes that groups outside of the school district (i.e. community, civic, non-profit and for-profit organizations) may want to distribute materials within the school district that are noncurricular. Noncurricular materials wishing to be distributed and that involve children and families, must be approved by the Director of Communications and meet certain standards prior to their distribution provided in Exhibit 903.5E1 JCSD Decision Making Matrix for Distribution of Materials by Outside Organizations.

It is the responsibility of the Superintendent and/or Director of Communications in conjunction with the building principals to draft administrative regulations regarding this policy.
