POLICY TITLE PROGRAM FOR STUDENTS AT RISK

No. 604.4

The Board recognizes that some students may require additional assistance in order to successfully complete the regular education program. The Board shall provide program services to encourage and support students and provide an opportunity for students "at risk" to achieve their potential and obtain their high school diploma.

It shall be the responsibility of the Superintendent or his/her designee to develop program services for students "at risk" which provides for identifying students, for program evaluation, and for training District personnel.
