POLICY TITLE GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE EDUCATION PROGRAM No. 600

The goals and objectives of the school district are designed to achieve the philosophy statement of the school district. An advisory committee of representatives of the school district community and the school district (SIAC) is appointed to make recommendations for the goals and objectives of the education program.

The role and purpose of SIAC is:

To serve in an advisory role to the school board on matters pertaining to:

- Major educational needs
- Student learning goals
- Long-range goals that include, but are not limited to, the state indicators that address reading, math, and science achievement
- Harassment or bullying prevention goals, programs, training, and other initiatives

At least annually, SIAC shall also make recommendations to the board with regard to, but not limited to, the following:

- Progress achieved with the annual improvement goals for the state indicators that address reading, mathematics, and science in subrule 12.8(3)
- Progress achieved with other locally determined core indicators
- Annual improvement goals for the state indicators that address reading, mathematics, and science achievement

Short-term and long-term objectives for the education program are established annually by the board. These objectives will reflect the results of the needs assessment, recommendation of the advisory committee, recommendations from the superintendent, and changes in law.

The board will report to SIAC regarding progress toward the achievement of the goals and objectives of the education program from the board's discussions.
