## **REQUIRED SUPPLIES**

### **2024-2025**

#### **ALL STUDENTS**

- JMS Daily Warm-Up Packet. This is available on the band Moodle Site.
- We recommend you keep a polishing rag with your instrument to preserve the finish.

#### **FLUTES**

- Soft rag and cleaning rod to clear out the instrument after each use.

#### **CLARINET**

- Plenty of reeds! Students should have a minimum of 4 working reed at all times.
- Reed Guard. These hold four reeds at a time and help prolong the life of the reeds when used properly. Reeds should NOT be left on the mouthpiece when putting the instrument away.
- Cleaning swab. Using the cleaning swab after each time you play the instrument will help save on costly replacement of pads in the future.

#### **TRUMPETS**

- Valve Oil (suggested brand: Blue Juice)
- Turning slide grease to keep the tuning slide moving freely.
- Mouthpiece brush for cleaning out the shank of the mouthpiece.
- Snake for cleaning out tubing.

#### **TROMBONES**

- Slide Lubricant (suggested brand: Slide-O-Mix)
- Tuning slide grease to keep the tuning slide moving freely.
- Mouthpiece brush for cleaning out the shank of the mouthpiece.
- Snake for cleaning out tubing.

#### **FRENCH HORNS, BARITONES, AND TUBAS**

- Valve oil
- Tuning slide grease to keep turning slides moving freely.

#### **PERCUSSION**

- Stick bag (Be sure your name is on the bag)
- Snare sticks (suggested: Vic Firth SD1)
- Medium yarn mallets
- Hard rubber mallets
- General purpose timpani mallets

#### **PERFORMANCE WARDROBE**

For concert band performances students will wear all black. Men and women should wear long black pants, a long-sleeved black shirt, black shoes, and black socks. No ties are necessary. In order to maintain uniformity, there will be no skirts, dresses, or short pants.
